THE MEDIAEVAL MANUSCRIPT COLLECTION**

The Collection of Manuscripts at Queens' College was originally described and listed by T H Horne in his full catalogue of the College Library (2 vols. 1827). The 21 most important mediaeval manuscripts were later catalogued by M R James in his "Descriptive Catalogue of the Western Manuscripts in the Library of Queens' College, Cambridge" (Cambridge, 1905). These have been microfilmed, together with nine others that were either described only by Horne, or added later.

The manuscript titles in this list are intended only as a guide and finding aid for the microfilm. The full detailed title and description of most of the manuscripts is to be found in the James Catalogue, from which the one line titles are taken and to which they directly correlate. The James Catalogue has also been microfilmed, and appears at the end of Reel 6.
