

# I: Law Manuscripts

The Law Manuscripts cover a wide range of Canonical, Ecclesiastical and Civil Law texts including Anglo-Saxon law terms, accounts of the High Court of Parliament and the Court of Chancery in the 16th and 17th centuries. Also included is a Decreta Pontificum of the 12th century from Christ Church Canterbury which contains a letter of Pope Alexander to Lanfranc. (Ms 405). Ms. 857 contains an account of the Gunpowder Plot and depositions of Guy Fawkes.
