MERTON COLLEGE

Merton possesses a far more traditional collection of theological manuscripts, encompassing most of the great mediaeval religious works.

The standard mediaeval works of the Church Fathers are present in manuscripts of varying ages, a tribute to the enduring popularity of Augustine, Gregory the Great and Jerome. Later writers such as Hugh of St Victor, Bonaventura and Aquinas were equally lasting; they seem to overshadow the works of English writers who were apparently less widely known. Merton does, however, possess several copies of Anselm's works (Mss 19, 20, 40 and 45) and one 14th and one 15th century manuscript of Bede. (Mss 175 and 177). In addition to these, the works of Oxford scholars such as Duns Scotus and William of Ockham form an important part of the collection.
