GENERAL RECORDS OF THE AMERICAN COMMISSION TO NEGOTIATE PEACE 1918-1931

On the 563 rolls of this microfilm publication are reproduced the 537 volumes of the central files of the American Commission To Negotiate Peace after World War I. These volumes contain the correspondence of the Commission; minutes and reports of the various committees, councils, commissions, field missions, and plenary sessions; minutes of the meetings of the Conference of Ambassadors, 1920-31; and memorandums, publications, pamphlets, maps, and personnel records.

Detailed lists (purport sheets) of the documents contained in these volumes are filmed on rolls 2-26. These purport sheets provide, in file order, the file number, sender, dates sent and received, and a brief description of each document. The file order of the records was imposed by the Department of State between 1930 and 1937 when the documents were arranged, indexed, and bound. It is a modification of the decimal system used by the Department of State for its central files.

These records are part of Records of the American Commission To Negotiate Peace, Record Group 256, which also contains the records of Colonel House's Inquiry; card files of European political parties, population, industrial matters, and religious and language statistics; files and indexes of European and American newspaper clippings; and digests of declarations and proposals made by participants in the Paris Peace Conference.

The records reproduced in this microfilm publication also contain numerous documents that have no relation to the questions considered by the Peace Conference; President Wilson and Secretary of State Lansing decided many matters of general policy while in Paris as members of the Commission.

The organization of the American Commission To Negotiate Peace was begun in November 1918 when President Wilson selected Col. E. M. House, Secretary of State Robert Lansing, Henry White, and Tasker A. Bliss as Commissioners Plenipotentiary to accompany him to Paris. The previous fall Wilson had asked House to organize the unofficial group of experts that became known as "The Inquiry." Several members of this group were among the technical advisors who accompanied the large secretariat of the Commission to the Conference.

The Commission went to Paris prepared to investigate and discuss matters regarding the postwar world. According to instructions given earlier, "the American negotiators must be in a position to judge whether a claim put forth by a power is supported by the democracy at home or whether it is merely a

traditional diplomatic objective or the design of an imperialistic group . . . In many cases the most important function of the American negotiators may be to expose the unscientific character of a statement of fact made by someone else."

The most valuable tool for the use of the Commission's central files is the Key, which is filmed on roll 1. It is not an index, but a supplement to the extensive and complicated card index. The Key describes the records in general and indicates how individual documents are filed. It also explains briefly the organizations of the Peace Conference and the Commission. For example, Supreme War Council, "Big Ten," and "Council of Ten" all refer to the Bureau of the Conference, and it is under this latter name that all records relating to it are found.

The annexes to the <u>Key</u> are interrelated. Annex I is an alphabetical index to subjects considered by the Conference and the Commission, with the appropriate file numbers. Page citations refer to pages in the classification scheme that indicate which committee, subcommittee, etc., considered the subject and how that committee fits into the organization of the Peace Conference.

Annex II describes in detail the councils, commissions, committees, etc., of the Peace Conference, and of the Field Missions of the American Commission, and also includes a chronological listing of each meeting with the names of members present at each session. It is followed by its own alphabetical index and a separate alphabetical name index to the members of the councils, commissions, committees, etc., and the committees on which they served.

Annex III provides an alphabetical index to subjects considered and the card index heading under which each is found.

Annex IV is a chronological listing of the meeting dates of the councils, commissions, committees, etc.

Annex V lists the personnel of the American Commission and the volume in which their personnel information may be found. The list also includes names of many prospective employees.

Annexes VI through X provide outlines of the various final treaties, with the file and volume to be searched for each article of each treaty. Annex VI is Germany (Versailles); Annex VII, Austria (St. Germain); Annex VIII, Hungary (Trianon); Annex IX, Bulgaria (Neuilly); and Annex X, Turkey (Sevres). Annex XI lists all of the treaties negotiated, with the file number for each.

Inquiry Document 889, p. 3, 4, and 6.

Annex XII lists the file numbers for each boundary question considered and the volume that contains the negotiation. Annex XIII is a numerical list of the bound volumes, showing the contents of each by decimal file numbers.

Following the <u>Key</u> is a three-part listing of the councils, commissions, and committees, etc., of the Peace Conference. Part I is an alphabetical descriptive list of these organizations, showing file number, date of appointment, by whom appointed, personnel, functions, and heading under which it is indexed. Part II is an alphabetical list of all persons who were members of missions to the Peace Conference and the committees, etc., they chaired or upon which they served. Part III lists the councils, commissions, and other bodies chronologically by date of establishment, by whom they were established, and the names of those attending each meeting. This is keyed to the descriptive list in part I.

A detailed card index to these records was also prepared by the Department of State. It has not been filmed, but is avail able for use at the National Archives Building.

Records in the National Archives of the United States relating to the Commission may be found in General Records of the Department of State, Record Group 59, in the decimal file, 1910-29. Most of this material is available on microfilm as part of the microfilm publication program. Arrangement of the decimal file is explained in M600, Manual for Classification of Correspondence, Department of State, 4th ed., 1938. In Records of Boundary and Claims Commissions and Arbitrations, Record Group 76, are records relating to U.S. claims against the Central Powers. In National Archives Collection of Foreign Records Seized, 1941-, Record Group 242, are records of the German Foreign Office and the Heeresarchiv.

These records were prepared for filming by Sandra K. Rangel, who also wrote the introductory material.
