LIST OF U.S. DIPLOMATIC OFFICERS 1789-1939

On the 3 rolls of this microfilm publication are reproduced the State Department's lists of U.S. diplomatic officers, by country, 1789-1939. For each diplomatic post are given the names of the officers with their titles or grades, nationalities, places of birth, residences when appointed, and dates of appointment. Occasionally a date of death, retirement, termination of service, or transfer to another post is given. The lists are arranged alphabetically by country, then by the class of officer, and finally by date of appointment.

Besides the list of diplomatic officers, Roll 1 contains a list of unusual changes in the diplomatic service and a list of diplomatic agents who were elected, commissioned, or otherwise authorized to perform in diplomatic positions abroad before the U.S. Constitution was adopted.

On Roll 3, immediately following the lists of diplomatic officers accredited to Spain, are the records of appointment of Secretaries of Embassies and Legations, 1915-39; and the names of Student Interpreters in China, 1902-24, in Japan, 1906-24, and in Turkey, 1909-16.

Other records in the National Archives containing lists of diplomatic and consular officers are the List of Diplomatic Officers Appointed, 1853-1909; List of Consuls and Commercial Agents, 1809-1909; List of Vice Consuls and Consular Agents, 1869-1908; and List of Consuls General, Consuls, Commercial Agents, and Consular Clerks, 1875-77. Lists of U.S. consular officers, 1789-1939, are reproduced on Microcopy 587. All of the lists are a part of the records in the National Archives designated as Record Group 59, General Records of the Department of State.
